



Object of the Game

To throw the pigs and score as many points in one turn as you can. The first player to score 100 points is the winner.

1 Case, 2 Pigs, 1 Scorepad, 2 Pencils



PIGGERICK
There once was a pig called Dellish,
Who wanted to thy in a glider.
She finally had a go,
But hated it so,
She jumped out and handed a sider!
(Sider - I Point)

Choose a player to go first. On your turn, toss both pigs simultaneously into the air. How did they land?

SIDER

Both pigs land on their same sides. (Eg. Both lying dot side up or each lying unmarked side up)

that have

UBLE TROTTER

20 POINTS
Both pigs land
in the Trotter
position.

SNOUTER

A snouty pig lands on it's snout and two front trotters. (The other pig is a Sider)

Playing the Game Remove the cover of the scorepad. This is to be used as a quick reference score chart during play.

One player is appointed the 'Swineherd' and is in charge of marking the individual scores onto the scorepad.

TROTTER trapport of 5 POINTS
One pig lands on all four trotters.
(The other pig is a Sider)



o POINTS

Pigs land on
opposite sides. Lose
all pig points for
that turn. (Eg: One
lying dot side up
and one lying
unmarked side up)









20 POINTS Both pigs land trotters up!
