



## Badge Machine Instructions - 25,38,45,58 and 77mm Micro Assembler

A basic but efficient machine which easily makes professional quality badges

## HERE'S HOW!





- Place one metal badge front into orange die. Place one piece of cut out artwork and one clear plastic disc on top of metal badge front.
- 3. Place chrome ring (A) on top.
- 4. Place aluminium centre punch (B) on top (like a top hat, see Pic. 1)
- Rotate so centre punch (B) is under handle and pull handle down. Badge front, picture and film will be lodged in chrome ring.
- 6. Place a pre-pinned plastic back smooth side up in chrome die, or for 25n m open back place a small silver ring, sharper edge upwards.
- 7. Place chrome ring (A) (with badge front and picture inside) on top.
- 8. Turn aluminium centre punch (B) over (see Pic. 2) and put on top so that it fits within the chrome ring (A)
- 9. Rotate so underneath handle and pull down
- 10. Remove (A) and (B) from press to reveal finished badge.

For 25mm open back insert copper "D" pin

## **Helpful Hints**

- i. Handle should bend upwards
- ii. Step by step videos are also available on our website www.buttons.co.uk or Youtube.com/user/badgemachine
- iii. For stability assembler can be mounted on a wooden base or a bench using pre-drilled holes
- iv. Handle requires a steady pull and does not require undue force
- v. Always use the cutter on a strong cutting board to ensure a good clean cut. Spare blades and cutting boards are available
- vi. Spacers 45mm and 58mm sizes need a spacer in the chrome die when making everything apart from keyrings.
